-Chh:- Inexercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 209 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of X-Ray Technician, Class-III in the Government Ayurved Hospitals under the Directorate of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the X-Ray Technician (under the Directorate of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy) Recruitment Rules, 1991.
2. Appointment to the post of X-Ray Technician, Class-III in the Government Ayurved Hospitals under the Directorate of Indian System of Medicine and Homoeopathy shall be made by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall-
 - (a) not be more than 28 years of age ;
 - (b) possess -
 - (i) a Bachelor degree in Science with physics as one of the subject;
 - (ii) the certificate of having passed the prescribed X-Ray Technician Training Course conducted by a recognised institution of Medical College in Gujarat;
 - (c) Possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and Hindi.

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate, who possesses exceptionally good qualification.

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance

with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, as amended, from time to time.

4. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.
5. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time.
6. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such training as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
7. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish security and surety bonds for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
