No.GP-119-A UH-1073.6828(88)-CHH :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, and in supersession of the existing recruitment Rules, prescribed under Government Notification, Panchyat and Health Deptt., No.GP-1190-AUH-1067/1664/N, dated the 10th May, 1968, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Technician, Panchakarma, Class-III on Ayurved side, in Government Hospitals and dispensaries namely :

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Technician (Panchkarma) Class-III, (Ayurved) Recruitment Rules, 1988.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Technician Panchkarma Class-III (Ayurved) in Government Ayurved Hospitals and Dispensaries shall be made either ;
 - (a) by promotion of a person of provide merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who have worked for not less than four years as Panchkarma servants, Class-IV and who possess educational qualifications prescribed in sub rule (b)(c) and (d) of rule 3 or
 - (b) by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule-2, a candidate shall-
 - (a) not be more than 28 years of age;
 - (b) have passed secondary school certificate examination or its equivalent examination,

- (c) have experience for a period of not less than two years in a Panchkarma department in any Government Ayurvedic Hospital or dispensary.
- (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and Hindi

Provided that preference may be given to a candidate who possesses exceptionally good qualifications or experience, or both:

Provided further that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in service of the Government of Gujarat and candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribes or a Socially and Educationally Backward Class in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rule 1967, as amended from time to time.

4. A selected candidate shall be on probation for a period of one year.
5. A selected candidate shall be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed in that behalf by Government from time to time.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish security and surety bonds in such forms and for such amount as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.


